DESCRIPTION	Tucked away on a secluded, 100-acre peninsula on the southeastern coast of Antigua, the 251-room St. James's Club & Villas, located just 40 minutes from Antigua's V.C. Bird International Airport (ANU), is ideal for family getaways or romantic retreats. The combination of the island's atmosphere with the resort's luxurious amenities and activities makes a one-of-a-kind Antiguan experience for vacationers. For on-property dining, both all-inclusive and European plan options are available.
WHAT'S NEW	The resort recently received a multi-million dollar renovation, which included the addition of 48 waterfront royal suites with personal concierge as well as two additional pools, a new fitness room and a beachside game room for teens.
ACCOMMODATIONS	<p>At St. James's Club, guests can choose from spacious suites, luxurious villas or chic guestrooms. The resort features two distinct accommodations choices: The Club with 215 guestrooms, plus restaurants, lounges and activity centers or The Village with 36 villas set along a softly sloping hillside.</p> <p>Guests staying at The Club enjoy guestrooms and suites decorated with wicker furnishings and terra cotta floors. Each includes a private balcony or terrace, air conditioning, ceiling fans, cable television, a full bathroom, a hair dryer, a safe, a direct-dial telephone and a radio-alarm clock.</p> <p>Guests staying in The Club's 48 waterfront royal suites can take advantage of private check-in area and dedicated concierge as well as the following in-suite amenities: HD, flat-screen televisions; iPod docking stations; DVD players and Internet access.</p>



Ideal for couples, families and groups, **The Village** offers 36 two-bedroom villas. Each two-bedroom villa has a private bath and shower, separate dining and living areas, a full kitchen, a balcony or patio overlooking Mamora Bay, plush bathrobes, air conditioning, ceiling fans and televisions. **Villa Pax**, a three-bedroom villa, accommodates up to eight people and includes a sundeck with a bar for open-air dining overlooking Mamora Bay, stainless steel kitchen, washer and dryer.

DINING

St. James's Club & Villas features four restaurants, plus a beachside picnic spot, Mamora Beach. Executive Chef John Samuel oversees all four resort restaurants.

Rainbow Garden is set amidst the resort's tropical gardens and is open for breakfast and lunch daily as well as for dinner on select evenings. Both buffet and a la carte choices are available. Guests can enjoy an international gala buffet and live calypso music every Monday evening.

Children's menus or options are available at St. James's Club & Villa restaurants.

Coco Beach Restaurant & Bar offers a casual Caribbean ambiance with ocean views and a selection of salads, soups, burgers and pastas. Afternoon tea is served daily on the patio from 4 to 5 p.m.

The Docksider offers American fare in addition to Caribbean-inspired dishes including freshly caught fish. On Thursday nights, guests can enjoy a live steel band, limbo contests and more.

Piccolo Mondo is the resort's fine dining restaurant and offers Mediterranean and Caribbean cuisine. Its hillside setting provides breathtaking bay views.



DRESS CODE

St. James's Club & Villas suggests a casual chic dress code. During the day, guests are asked to wear shoes and cover bathing suits while dining in the restaurants. After 6:30 p.m. Coco's and The Docksider require a resort casual attire – flip-flops, tennis shoes, t-shirts and tank tops are not permitted. After 6:30 p.m. at Rainbow Garden, Piccolo Mondo and during the weekly manager cocktail parties guests must wear long pants, dress shorts, skirts, dresses and dress shoes or dress sandals.

BARS AND LOUNGES

St. James's Club & Villas offers five bars and lounges. **The Reef Deck Bar** offers daytime service by the main pool, and the three beach bars, **Mamora Bay Bar**, **Coco Beach Bar** and **Royal St James's Club Poolside Bar**, specialize in the resort's delicious rum punch. A beach cart with soda, beer, rum and fruit punch serves refreshments to sun bathers. In the evenings, the **Jacaranda Lounge** features live entertainment, and on Thursdays, **The Docksider Restaurant & Bar** hosts Caribbean Calypso Night with steel-pan performers.

SPA

Spa Tranquility has two massage suites that offer private bathrooms and showers. Guests can choose from a wide selection of treatments, including the black magma treatment, which incorporates a natural healing mud. Spa Tranquility features Pevonia Botanica spa products.

ACTIVITIES

With a billiard room, six tennis courts, six pools, a marina and a spa, St. James's Club offers a diverse selection of activities from which guests can choose. Complimentary non-motorized water sports include snorkeling, windsurfing, sailing, pedal boating and kayaking. Diving, including scuba instruction is also available. Off-property excursions including horseback riding and deep sea fishing can be arranged at the tour desk for an additional fee.

FAMILIES

The award-winning **Just for Kids Club** offers adult supervision and activities for potty-trained children, ages 4 to 11, from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. A bouncy castle, race car set, outdoor playhouse and picnic table were recently added. Children can even dine at the club while parents enjoy a private dinner alone. Babysitting can be arranged for an additional fee.



A new beachside, open-air **Teen Room** features pool tables, plus a Nintendo Wii system. Teens can enjoy a teens-only party held bi-weekly during high season and peak holiday weeks. Activities include karaoke, food, music, dancing and more.
